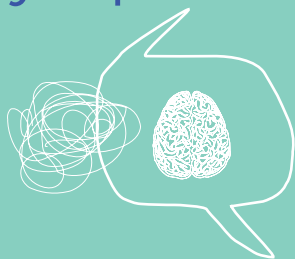


/asia pacific art and mental health symposium/
