

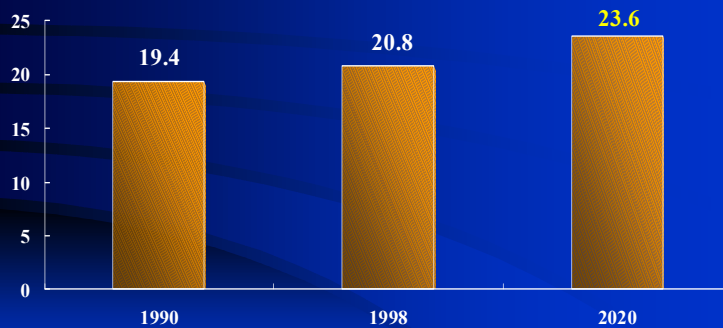

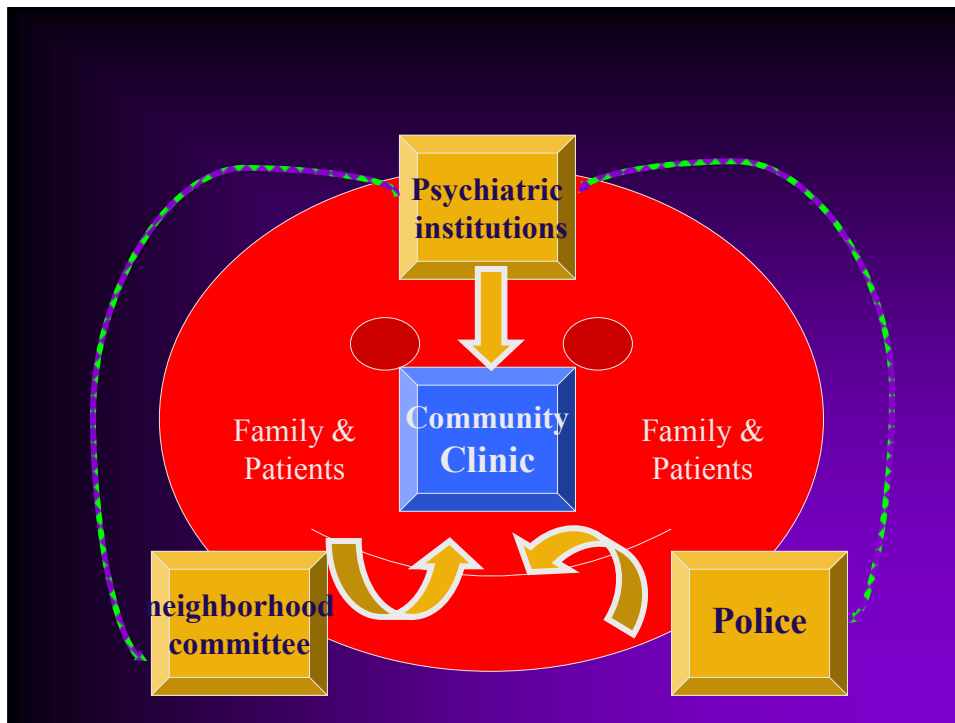
A few clinical psychologists, several social workers, no occupational therapists

National Reform Program

- Demonstration areas: **60**
- each province has two: **one rural, one urban**
- each area covers **400,000 population; actually 42.9 million**

2005: training, 6,860,000 RMB

- Project management
 - Standardized treatment
 - Case management
 - Family education
 - Training of police and neighborhood committee
 - Case information collection
- Development of teaching materials and training
- Design of computer software and website

2006: intervention, 10,000,000 RMB

Contents	Number of pts per area
To screen and record people with psychoses, and to enter data into national database	1000
To fulfill diagnostic review and risk assessment for above pts with potential violence	400
To follow up pts with potential violence monthly	400
To provide free medications for 120 poor pts with potential violence	120

Contents	Number of pts
To provide free lab tests for poor pts	120
To provide free outcome evaluation and remedy adjustment for poor pts	120
To provide free crisis intervention for pts with violence	80
To provide free hospitalization for 20 poor pts with violence	20

2007: interv+training, 15,000,000 RMB



To train multi-functional key workers: treatment, nursing, case management.

Changes

- **Attitudes: governments, psychiatric hospitals, other physicians**
- **Preliminary construction of network: psychiatric hospital lead, GH/CDC supported, community-based**
- **Public health capacity**
- **Benefit pts**
- **Social harmony**

Main difficulties

- **Large needs, limited fund**
- **Insufficient support for staff work**
- **Insufficient capacity, needs of training**

Main difficulties

- **Insufficient capacity, needs of training**
 - **community staff: follow-up, data quality**
 - **psychiatrists/ psy. nurses: public health, project quality control, technical instruction, standardized diagnosis and treatment, data quality control**
